Rote is an Indonesian island in East Nusa Tenggara and the country's southernmost territory. Largely untouched by mass tourism, Rote remains a remote tropical paradise, known for its white sand beaches, dramatic cliffs, caves, mangroves, pristine forests, and world-class surf breaks — the island's main attraction.

Getting to Manduna Resort involves three steps:

- 1. Fly to Kupang from Bali, Jakarta, or Surabaya.
- 2. **Take a short flight or ferry** from Kupang to Rote.
- 3. **Drive** to Manduna Resort.

Please note that flight schedules may require an overnight stay in Kupang, and some flights operate only a few times a week — so it's important to plan accordingly. If you're traveling with sports equipment, such as surfboards, we recommend arranging additional logistics in advance. We encourage you to reach out to us to coordinate transfers between the airports, ferry ports, and hotel to minimize any unnecessary stress throughout the journey.





Kupang is the capital of East Nusa Tenggara, located on the western tip of Timor Island near the Timor-Leste border. As the main gateway to remote islands like Rote, Sabu, Alor, and Flores, Kupang's El Tari Airport (KOE) connects travelers to major hubs such as Bali, Jakarta, and Surabaya — making it an essential stop en route to Rote. If your journey requires an overnight stay in Kupang, we recommend staying at the <u>Aston Kupang Hotel</u>.

From Kupang, you can reach Rote either by a short domestic flight (about 30 minutes) or by ferry, which takes approximately 2–3 hours depending on the vessel. Flights are quicker but may have limited schedules, while ferries run regularly but are weather-dependent. Both options arrive in Ba'a, Rote's main town, from where a Manduna Resort car will bring you to your accommodation. We recommend booking flight tickets via Irraveloka.

Getting home from Rote is basically the journey in reverse, though some flight times may differ. Take the ferry or flight to Kupang, then connect to Bali, Jakarta, or Surabaya. Always check schedules in advance, as weather can affect connections.

If you're taking a ferry to Rote on the same day as your arrival to Kupang, we recommend arriving in Kupang early to account for any potential delays. During peak travel seasons, booking flights well in advance is highly advised to ensure availability. The team at Manduna Resort is always available to assist with any necessary information, and can purchase your ferry tickets on your behalf to help create a smooth journey.

If you're flying from Kupang to Rote (or vice versa) and traveling with surfboards, please contact us in advance so we can coordinate the transportation of your boards. The aircrafts between these destinations are small and have limited space. We can arrange for the boards to travel separately via ferry and ensure their arrival with the assistance of a driver.
